The United Way Amarillo & Canyon established the COVID-19 Emergency
Relief Fund to provide direct aid to those affected. As the situation
developed, it was clear the challenges this virus extended beyond just
those infected and their loved ones, but to every citizen of Amarillo &
Canyon who are living paycheck to paycheck. Given the social distancing
required to combat the spread of the disease, individuals, most of whom
were hourly wage earners in service industry jobs, would experience
unprecedented economic hardship.

In response to this, the emergency relief fund was allocated to local 501c3 nonprofit agencies who directly impact the lives of individuals who experienced lack of basic needs being met. i.e., food, shelter, utilities, etc.

All donations to the funds were granted to community-based organizations that directly supported residents and families who were most affected by emerging health, economic, and social impacts.
